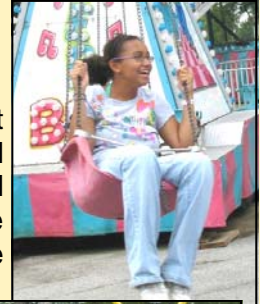

Freshman, **Daniel G.** and Sophomore **Mentoe B.** have made the Soccer team for Bowling Green High School.

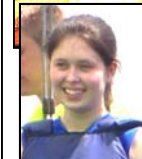
